GPSG Action: Passed

A BILL

GPSG commits to providing the Winter Clothing Drive at Iowa with an additional \$10,000.00 in FY26.

Section 1: Short Title

This bill may be cited as "Winter Clothing Drive FY26 Supplement".

Section 2: Discussion

WHEREAS, Basic Needs at Iowa, a program under the Dean of Students Office within the Division of Student Life, administers a Winter Coat Distribution Program, which provides free winter clothing items to Iowa students in need;

WHEREAS, these winter clothing items include coats, hats, gloves, and other essentials crucial to keeping students warm throughout the winter months;

WHEREAS, in FY25, the Winter Clothing Drive distributed <u>225</u> new or gently used coats to Iowa students;

WHEREAS, the Clothing Closet at Iowa has been temporarily paused due to the Iowa Memorial Union Renovation Project;

WHEREAS, a primary source of funding for the Winter Clothing Drive has been the University Iowa Student Governments (UISG);

WHEREAS, the 2025-2026 GPSG administration has made it a priority to support programming and services that help graduate and professional students access basic needs;

WHEREAS, the GPSG FY26 Contingency Spend-Down Plan prioritizes additional support to the Winter Clothing Drive in order to further GPSG's commitment to supporting Graduate and Professional students;

WHEREAS, any GPSG spending in excess of \$1,500.00 must be voted on for approval by the GPSG delegates;

WHEREAS, GPSG's Contingency Account for FY26 is in a position that enables GPSG to allocate additional financial resources to support student services;

WHEREAS, GPSG intends that this block of funding to the Winter Clothing Drive will last beyond the 2025-2026 academic year. GPSG recommends that these funds are used in gradual amounts over the coming 4 fiscal years in consistent amounts;

Section 3: Action

Therefore, be it Resolved, GPSG will allocate \$10,000.00 from its Contingency Account to the Winter Clothing Drive in FY26.

Section 4: Enactment

THEREFORE, be it enacted by the University of Iowa Graduate and Professional Student Government upon the signature of the President.
