**A BILL**

To allocated funds for the inaugural issue of *The Edition*, a graduate and professional student  
periodical produced by GPSG’s Editorial Committee, established under D.B. #6.

---

**Section 1: Short Title**

This bill may be cited as the “Allocation for Printing *The Edition*”.

**Section 2: Discussion**

**WHEREAS**, Graduate and Professional Student Government (GPSG) formed the ad-hoc  
Editorial Committee through D.B. #6 in November of 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, this committee was formed for the purpose of planning and producing graduate and  
professional student-run publication, hereafter referred to as *The Edition*; and

**WHEREAS**, D.B. #6 charges the committee with the production and distribution in the spring  
semester of 2026 of *The Edition* in both printed and digital formats; and

**WHEREAS**, the Editorial Committee has curated the content of *The Edition* and will be printing  
and distributing physical copies of the paper in forthcoming weeks; and

**WHEREAS**, an allocation equal to and no more than \$1,500 will be sufficient to print a modest number of copies for distribution around campus for the initial pilot issue of *The Edition*.

**Section 3: Action**

**Resolved**, GPSG will allocate up to a maximum of \$1,500 from its reserves for all printing and shipping costs associated with the publication of *The Edition* for circulation on campus to graduate and professional students; and

**Therefore, be it Resolved**, that GPSG will allocate no more than \$1,500 from its Contingency Account for all printing and shipping costs associated with the production of *The Edition*.

**Section 4: Enactment**

**THEREFORE**, be it enacted by the University of Iowa Graduate and Professional Student Government upon the signature of the President.
